PART I

This ship, with Air Group FORTY aboard, participated in the occupation of Balikpapan, Borneo, during the period 30 June to 3 July 1945, providing air cover for the naval forces involved and air cover and direct air support for the ground forces during the assault and landing phases and subsequent operations.

PART II

This ship operated as part of Task Unit Seventy-Eight point Four point One, which comprised SUWANNEE (CVE-27), BLOCK ISLAND (CVE-106), and GILBERT ISLANDS (CVE-107). This Task Unit was under the operational command of Task Group Seventy-Eight point Four.

PART III - CHRONOLOGICAL ACCOUNT

A. Weather.

- 1. Weather conditions in the operating area were generally favorable for flight operations. Over the target area, however, cloud cover constituted a slight handicap to bombing operations and observation.
- 2. Copies of weather reports are enclosed (Enclosure "A") covering the period of operations in the Balikpapan area.
- B. A navigational track of the ship is enclosed (Enclosure "B").

C. Chronological Account.

- 1945 26 June Departed San Pedro Bay (Leyte) at 0607(I). Gunnery exercises with towed targets. Recovered planes from Tacloban Airfield.
- 27 June Flew local patrols. Conducted training exercises and gunnery exercises.
- 28 June Flew local patrols. Conducted training exercises.
- 29 June Flew local patrols.
- 30 June Flew local patrols, and target combat air patrols over Balikpapan area.
- 1 July Flew local patrols, target combat air patrols and support missions over Balikpapan.
- 2 July Flew special search for enemy vessels reported approaching from south; also local patrols and target combat air patrols over Balikpapan.
- 3 July Flew local patrols, target combat air patrols and support missions over Balikpapan. Departed Balikpapan area at 1716(I).
- 4 July Flew local patrols.
- 5 July Flew local patrols.
- 6 July Dropped anchor in San Pedro Bay (Leyte) at 1532(I).
