

Armsber of buildings were strafed in areas Q-W-L-W and a gan position was strafed in Botween E & L. Accurate results were fandleapped by poor visibility due to smoke and debris.
- 2. The This was told to drop his bombs two at a time, but after the second run, the pilot was told to secure. All of these bombs dropped in NE corner of L. Results uncheerved.
