

at 0515 K, 20 June 1944. Remains not recovered.

Lt(jg) John Campbell SIMPSON, A-V(N), USNR, (145571).
Killed in plane crash following severe damage to plane
by enemy anti-aircraft fire. Body recovered, identified,
and delivered to Burial Authorities, Saipan Island.
